Die Nosa Bonsmara stoet



Die Nosa Bonsmara stoet het in 1981 ontstaan toe, Afrikaner en Suid-Devon kruiskoeie as basis Bonsmara koeie gekeur is, my pa het ook by Gerhard Bronn in die verre Noord Transvaal op daardie stadium 'n gerekende stoetteler 'n paar stoekoeie gekoop. Die stoet se naam is afgelei van my en my middelste suster se name Arno en Elsa, my jongste suster was toe nog nie gebore nie. Die kudde voorvoegsel AEJ staan vir Arno, Elsa en Jan.

My oupa Breda aan my ma se kant het my pa gespot en gesê ons boer op die wenakkers met ons beeste, my pa het weidingsgrond in Boshof distrik gehad en bietjie panwalle en uitval grond waar ons vandag in die Bultfonteindistrik boer.

Die grond omskakelings skema van die destydse Departement landbou het twee doele gehad om die groot mielie oorskot wat geproduseer is na die rekord oes van 1981 te verminder en om die marginale akkerbou gedeeltes om te skakel na weidings. Op daardie tydstip in die geskiedenis het Suid-Afrika 'n een kanaal bemarkings skema gehad en alle grane moes deur bemarkingsrade bemark word en pryse is deur die regering vasgestel. Beesboerdery het bietjie stabiliteit na 'n baie volatile graanbedryf gebring. Ons

gebruik beeste om gras en oesreste wat nie 'n groot mark en geldwaarde het nie, maar vir ons baie beteken in 'n bemarkbare protein om te skakel.


Smutsvinger gras was in ons deel van die wêreld die aanbevole gras om te vestig en baie hektare is omgeskakel na weidings toe, smutsvinger vorm nog vandag 'n hoeksteen van ons voervloeiprogram. Die lande wat omgeskakel is het dit moontlik gemaak om die getalle nog uit te brei. Mieliereste help ons om deur die winter te ko men aangeplante en natuurlike weiding word gerus om benut te word as die lande se voorbereiding begin en die beeste moet skuif.

Die wintertropkoeie loop die hele jaar tussen Bultfontein en Hoopstad waar ek bly en ons somertrop loop by my pa op Kareeboombult in Hoopstad waar ons veiling ook aangebied. In die winter kom daardie trop ook mielielande toe. In die laat 1990's het my pa nog grond in Hoopstad bygekoop, die plaas het natuurlike weiding met al die grasse en kameeldoringbome van die Kalahari, die swakker akkerbou grond is ook omgeskakel na weidings. In daardie tyd het hy ook die grootste deel van 'n stoet uitgekoop van telers wat nie meer wou aangaan met die stoetary nie.





Ons bulle word op 2,5 tot 3 jaar verkoop nadat hul 'n Fase D op die plaas voltooi het, die jongbulle word almal op ons kommersiële beeste in Brandfort gebruik, die sterker jongbulle gebruik ons in die stoet. Die dragtige kommersiële vroulike diere wat ons bemark het meestal klaar gekalf die wat nog nie gekalf het, hou ons op die plaas tot hul klaar gekalf het en ons waarborg jou 'n kalf. Ons bied ook 400km gratis aflewering binne Suid Afrika op al die bulle en kommersiële beeste wat op die veiling verkoop word.



Ons gee ons beste om aanpasbare beeste te teel wat aanpas in groot dele van die land en ons sal as die Lieve Vader en die weer dit toelaat vanjaar ons 29ste produksieveiling op die plaas Kareeboombult in die Hoopstad distrik hou.



Biomarkers – a New Method to Analyse Mycotoxin Exposure



Mycotoxins are dangerous toxins produced by naturally occurring fungi and mould that are present in varying degrees in agricultural products. The continued increase in global populations, coupled with an increase in animal protein consumption due to higher living standards has resulted in more pressure on the livestock industry. Food safety issues, which include amongst others the effect of mycotoxins on animals, has now become increasingly important.

Mycotoxin contamination often occurs while feed products are being prepared and stored, as well as when mould starts to grow in the fields due to ideal moisture and temperature conditions. In South Africa, zearalenone, T-2 toxin, vomitoxin, aflatoxins, ochratoxins, fumonisins, and t-2 toxins are the most significant mycotoxins found in feeds and food. Toxic effects on animals are typically caused by a combination of two or more different mycotoxins rather than by a single mycotoxin.

Aflatoxins

Aflatoxin contamination of feed and feed products are reported yearly on a global scale. Aflatoxin-related problems in animals include everything from chronic illness to unexpected death. Aflatoxins are also known to harm the livers of animals, leading to conditions such as liver degeneration, necrosis, and altered liver function. Aflatoxins poisoning may not necessarily have overt symptoms, although one common indicator in young animals, is slow growth rate.

Ochratoxins

Like aflatoxins, ochratoxins are extremely dangerous since they affect optimal kidney

function of all livestock and, in very high amounts, may also cause hepatotoxicity. According to research, ochratoxins can result in a variety of embryonic abnormalities as well as a lowered birth weight.

Zearalenone

Zearalenone and ergot alkaloids are considered important as they are present in most raw materials used for animal consumption.

Zearalenone causes an oestrogenic response in animals by interacting with estrogen receptors. A few of its estrogenic adverse effects include decreased fertility, a rise in embryo foetal resorptions, smaller litters, altered progesterone levels, and birth abnormalities in pigs and small ruminants.

Zearalenone is known to induce vaginitis, increased vaginal discharge, mammary gland enlargement, poor reproductive function, reduced feed intake, decreased milk output, and abortions in dairy calves.

Pigs are the most sensitive of farm animals to zearalenone; some consequences include enlarged vulva and mammary glands, longer

estrus intervals, vulvovaginitis, vaginal and/or rectal prolapse, ovarian atrophy, disturbed conceptions, abortions, and infertility in pigs. Zearalenone can have an impact on boars by inducing feminisation, resulting in testicular atrophy, swollen prepuces, and expression of the mammary glands.

Fumonisins

Fumonisin-contaminated feed increase animal death rates by causing pulmonary oedema, liver and pancreatic damage, weight loss, and compromised immunological function.

Trichothecenes (Don, T-2 toxin, and DAS)

Mycotoxins called trichothecenes can be found in cereals, commercial feed, and mixed feed. Trichothecenes reduce feed intake in animals, which results in weight loss, melaena, diarrhea, sores in the mouth, abortions, and death. The animal's oral lesions cause feed refusal and in extreme circumstances vomiting.

Economic Importance

Mycotoxins not only affect animal health, but it also has significant economic repercussions. In addition to the negative consequences mycotoxins have on animal production, crops that are severely tainted with mycotoxins must be eradicated, which represents a huge loss to crop farmers. Mycotoxins have a detrimental effect on the yield and nutritional value of forage and grain. The explanation for this is that mould consumes the nutrients in the feed to survive, causing the feed to have a reduced energy content and necessitating farmers to spend more money on supplemental feed to ensure that animals grow appropriately.

Control of Mycotoxins

Due to the catastrophic effects mycotoxins have on livestock, methods to clean and detoxify mycotoxin-contaminated food and feed have been developed. Physical techniques, chemical techniques, biological techniques, and nutritional techniques are all included in these efforts. Adding absorbents to animal feed is the method most usually used to protect livestock from mycotoxins.


A popular physical technique for treating feed tainted with mycotoxins, is absorption. This technique makes use of absorption binders



that combine with the mycotoxins to generate a complex molecule that cannot be absorbed in the gastrointestinal tract. Different mycotoxin absorption binders are offered to farmers by Agri FARMACY SA to aid in the detoxification of feed and raw feed components. In addition to supplying mycotoxin binders, Agri FARMACY Professional Services also provides veterinary and nutritionist services for farmers. We help with in-feed sampling and, biosecurity feed mill audits are also done. The process of sampling feed is tedious and needs to be done correctly so as to avoid contamination, that may lead to misleading results. Detection of Mycotoxins

The common method to detect mycotoxin contamination is through feed analysis⁶. The problem with this traditional method is that mycotoxin organisms create hotspots in the feed. This causes some areas in the feed to have a higher concentration of mycotoxins than other areas, making sampling of feeds nonconstant, leading to an irregular sample representative. Another negative aspect of feed analysis is no information is available of individual exposure, which causes variations in affected animals due to differences in feed consumption/absorption, feed distribution and important metabolic



processes. Another issue with feed analysis is that it only focusses on the feed contamination and not on alternative routes for poisoning such as dermal and respiratory exposure. Masked mycotoxins pose another threat to animal health, as they cannot be detected with conventional feed analysis tests. Masked mycotoxins are by-products of mycotoxins, their molecule structure changed to be part of the plant which gave it the name "masked" mycotoxins. When masked mycotoxins are ingested, they can convert back to harmful agents and cause symptoms related to mycotoxin exposure. In other words, masked mycotoxins cause clinical signs, but the feed results represent low levels of mycotoxin contamination. All of the statements above cause a mismatch between the mycotoxin contamination level of animal feed and animal exposure, which can be resolved with the analysis of animal biological matrices. Biological matrices like urine, blood and/or faeces are used as biomarkers to analyse mycotoxin exposure in the metabolic system of the animal. Fortunately, such analysis exists with Innovad®, a global supplier of animal health and nutritional solutions.

For the first time it is possible to achieve what was theorised as the best method to correctly assess

the true exposure of animals to mycotoxins, by detecting them and their metabolites in bodily fluids, in this case animals' blood. This diagnostic tool is called the Myco-Marker®. Innovad® has validated and patented a method to currently determine 36 different mycotoxin biomarkers in blood using so-called FDA cards. The cards offer a simple means to easily collect blood spots and dispatch them for analysis to their lab without restrictions. The blood analysis, applied with the Myco-Marker® service demonstrates that feed analysis alone does not provide a sufficient overview of the mycotoxin risk. The added value of combining feed and blood analysis to uncover mycotoxin risk has revealed that most cases (80%) of mycotoxin exposure would have been missed if only the feed was analysed.

Lewerslak in beeste en skape

In Suid-Afrika word daar twee soorte lewerslakspesies aangetref, naamlik die reuse-lewerslak (*Fasciola gigantica*) en die gewone lewerslak (*Fasciola hepatica*).

Die lewensiklus van die lewerslak is indirek. Die tussengasheer by die reuse-lewerslak is die varswaterslak, *Lymnaea natalensis*, en by die gewone lewerslak is dit *Lymnaea truncatula*. *Lymnaea columella* kan as tussengasheer vir beide die reuse- en gewone lewerslak optree.

Eiers word in die mis van die herkouer uitgeskei en onder gunstige toestande vorm die oerlarfstadium (*miracidia*) binne sowat 14 dae. Die oerlarwes dring die varwaterslak binne en ontwikkel na die larfstadium (*cercaria*). Die larwes verlaat later die varwaterslak en heg aan plant- materiaal vas. Daar ontwikkel dit na die besmetlike larfstadium (*metacercaria*) wat die infektiewe stadium van die lewensiklus is. Die besmetlike larfies kan vir 'n geruime tyd op die weiding bly.

Die besmetlike larf verloor sy omhulsel in die dunderm en ontwikkel na 'n onvolwasse lewerslakkie, penetreer deur die dunderm- wand tot in die buikholte, beweeg na die lewer, dring dit binne en begin dan deur die lewerweefsel vreet. Die volwasse stadium vestig in die galbuise en skei konstant eiers uit. Die eiers beweeg vanaf die galbuise tot in die dermkanaal en word in die mis uitgeskei.

Die volwasse lewerslak kan vir tot 'n jaar in die galbuise oorleef en eiers produseer.

Onvolwasse lewerslakkies wat deur die lewer migrer en vreet, veroorsaak skade en inflammasie. Matige bloedverlies kan tydens migrasie voorkom as gevolg van die skade wat aangerig word. Erge bloedar- moede word gewoonlik gesien wanneer die lewerslakke volwassenheid bereik, aan- gesien die volwasse stadiums aggressiewe bloedsuiers is. Diere verloor dan kosbare proteïene, en groei en immunitet word belemmer. Diere kan ook skielik vrek as gevolg van inwendige bloeding wanneer die skade te groot is.

Kliniese simptome kan wissel van akute vrektes tot bloedarmoede en redelike vinnige gewigsverlies in sub-akute gevalle tot bloedarmoede, kroniese gewigsverlies, vog in die buikholte en kwakkeel in kroniese gevalle. Diere kan tussen 12 en 20 weke na infeksie doodgaan sonder behandeling.

Beeste versus skape

Beeste ontwikkel 'n mate van weerstand teen lewerslakparasiete en volwasse lewerslakke leef gewoonlik vir nege tot 12 maande in die galbuise voordat hulle uitge- skei word. Beeste kan egter steeds negatief geraak word.

Skape is baie meer vatbaar vir die neweffekte wat lewerslakke veroorsaak as beeste,

en vrek oor die algemeen makliker weens 'n lewerslakbesmetting.

In akute gevalle toon nadoodse onder- soeke soms erge bloeding in die buikholte. 'Bloedspore' kan soms waargeneem word wanneer die lever van naby ondersoek word. In meer kroniese gevalle is wit gedeeltes van bindweefselvorming (fibrose) en klassieke 'pypsteelfibrose' om die galbuise sigbaar. Sekondêre infeksie kan ook absesse in die lever veroorsaak.

Strategiese behandeling

Laatherfs-/winterbehandeling word toegepas om die volwasse lewerslaktekke te dood om die lewerslakeieruitskeiding te verminder en besmetting van weidings te voorkom. 'n Doseermiddel met triklaben- dasool sal alle stadia van lewerslak vanaf twee weke (gewone lewerslak) of drie weke (reuse-lewerslak) tot die volwasse stadia (12+ weke) dood. Triklabendasool is die enigste lewerslakmiddel wat dit kan doen.

Lentebehandeling word toegepas om die stadia wat die winterbehandeling oorleef het te dood,

asook om lewerslakeier- uitskeiding hok te slaan en weidingsbesmet- ting te voorkom. 'n Middel wat klosantel of rafoksanied bevat kan gebruik word. Triklabendasool kan ook gebruik word.

In gebiede waar lewerslakbesmetting 'n ernstige probleem is, kan **somerbehande- ling** opioneel toegepas word.

Taktiese beheer

Taktiese behandeling word gewoonlik by kliniese gevalle toegepas. 'n Middel soos triklabendasool wat onvolwasse en vol- wasse stadia dood, moet dus gebruik word. Tydens 'n lewerslakuitbreking moet diere verkieslik na droër gebiede geskuif word en elke twee tot drie weke behandel word.

Lewerslak kan tot 'n mate beheer word deur toegang tot nat gebiede soos vleie en riviere te beperk. Die gebiede kan afge- kamp word, maar dit is nie altyd prakties nie. Chemiese beheer van die slaktekke is al voorgestel maar word nie aanbeveel nie.

NAMPO Cape 2024 was launched to the media on Friday, 19 July. At the event, Christiaan Neethling, Former Chairperson, gave a retrospective of the first Mechanisation Day held in the Bredasdorp area in 1994 under the leadership of the late Niel Giliomee. These humble beginnings, with 10 exhibitors, grew with passion and enthusiasm into the successful NAMPO Cape Expo with 34 635 visitors and 516 exhibitors in 2023.

Henk Aggenbach, Chairperson of the Bredasdorp Park Board, which hosts NAMPO Cape in collaboration with Grain SA, lifted the veil on what visitors can expect at the fifth presentation of NAMPO Cape. "There are already about 530 exhibitors allocated to 600 plots, and there are still exhibitors on the waiting list. Some of the new items on the NAMPO Cape menu are the Greenworks Demonstration Track where battery-powered vehicles are tested and demonstrated and visitors will see the South African Champion sheepdogs and their handlers in action in the BKB Livestock Centre where sheepdog training and competitions are held. The graceful Lipizzaner horses will once again wow visitors with their dances in the Western Cape Lubricants Arena. This year's Women's Programme in the Distinctive Choice tent and the flowers in the Voermol- and Neptun halls will ensure that the women attending NAMPO Cape ask their husbands to stay a little longer!"

Aggenbach also invited farmers, farm workers and learners to enter their patents in the NAMPO Cape Farmers' Plans competition. He also

encouraged visitors to buy their tickets online at www.ticketpros.co.za. In this way they not only save R20 per adult, but save a lot of time because they do not have to wait in long lines to access the site.

Dr Tobias Doyer, CEO, Grain SA, placed the Western Cape Grain Industry under the magnifying glass. According to Doyer, the focus areas in the grain industry are to optimise production, unlock new markets, transform the food system and conserve the soil for generations to come. "NAMPO Cape is the platform where producers and suppliers come together to reflect on the cost/price squeeze. The challenge today is for farmers to produce more with less, and new technology is the key to success."

During NAMPO Cape there are 4 ha grain trials where suppliers showcase new technology in grain production. NAMPO Cape also offers a schools programme where learners with agricultural technology and agricultural management can experience what they learn in the classroom in practice.



Dr Ivan Meyer, Minister of Agriculture, Economic Development and Tourism in the Western Cape, explained the implications of the Government of National Unit for Agriculture in the Western Cape: "Agriculture has experienced 30 years of fundamental uncertainty, but in the RNE, agriculture is a pillar of economic growth and food security a priority. Agriculture is the engine of job creation and economic growth and therefore the voice of farmers and farm workers needs to be heard in Parliament."

According to Dr Meyer, biosecurity and phytosanitary interventions are high on the list of priorities for both the National Department of Agriculture and the Western Cape Government. "Given the threat of FMD to the cattle industry, livestock owners should remain vigilant, step up their biosecurity measures and take all possible precautions to prevent the disease from spreading to the Western Cape." Western Cape Premier Alan Winde requested Meyer to urgently write to National Agriculture Minister, John Steenhuisen, requesting him to introduce a temporary ban on the movement of livestock to the Western Cape.

Five women leading the livestock revolution in Africa

There are approximately 249 million women livestock keepers in Africa for whom livestock represents a major source of income and an opportunity for wealth accumulation. While the majority of them are backyard livestock producers, a few have elevated their production to successful commercial companies.

Women livestock producers across Africa play a critical role in reducing hunger and creating job opportunities for Africa's youth. However, they often face steep barriers in advancing their initiatives. Access to land, finance, markets, training and information remain a greater challenge to women than their male counterparts. On the other hand, ownership of livestock is widely recognized as an important aspect of women's economic empowerment. Women can receive livestock through inheritance, before or during marriage, or from farmer associations. Alternatively, they may opt to purchase animals directly. In particular, small ruminants and poultry require smaller capital investments thus providing an easy entry point for their participation in livestock markets.

This blog celebrates the women that have overcome immense personal, social, cultural and economic hurdles to build and grow successful enterprises in poultry, camel milk, dairy and pigs.

Anta Babacar Ngom

Anta Babacar Ngom is the Executive Director of SEDIMA Group, Senegal's leading poultry production group. Established in 1976 by her father, the Sedima Group is a vertically integrated poultry business, consisting of a feed mills, hatcheries, breeding farms and an abattoir. Anta Babacar Ngom took over the business from her father in 2009 and became Executive Director in 2016. She has since steered the company's diversification and expansion into Democratic Republic of Congo, Equatorial Guinea and Mali. In January 2017, the company invested US\$ 29 million in a highly automated processing plant, where all the activities from live-bird handling to electrical stunning, scalding, defeathering, evisceration, water chilling, and grading are carried out. Some 780 people are employed directly at the plant, which has the capacity to process up to 6,000 birds per hour, all of which are halal, to serve Senegal's largely Muslim market. The output from the processing plant also feeds directly into two KFC restaurants in Dakar, with which Sedima has a national franchise agreement.

Nancy Abeid Arahame, Tiviski, Mauritania

Nancy Abeid Arahame

In Mauritania, female engineer and entrepreneur Nancy Abeid Arahame established Africa's first camel milk dairy in 1989. Based in Nouakchott, Tiviski now produces over 20 different products out of camel, cow, and goat milk. The milk is collected at three collection centers from nomadic pastoralists, some dispersed as far as 800 km from Nouakchott. Tiviski's products are sold at supermarkets and numerous small shops in the capital city. The company is also looking to export camel cheese to European markets, but regulatory hurdles have limited access. By 2016, the company had already acquired half of the Mauritanian pasteurized milk market. It received a US\$9.5 million investment from the International Finance Corporation (IFC) and the Global Agriculture and Food Security Program (GAFSP) in 2016 to expedite its modernization and diversification and expand its milk production. This investment has unlocked the company's capacity to process milk from over 2,000 livestock herders from across the Mauritania Sahara, 15 percent of whom are women. The company has created over 200 direct jobs at the dairies, all of which are allocated to Mauritians, and further indirect jobs for milk collectors in Mauritania's Trarza and Brakna regions.

Nonny Penelope Wright

Nonny Penelope Wright founded Lopey Inc and the Sereledi dairy brands in 2013 in Ngamiland, north western Botswana. In the short timeframe that her enterprise has been running, the resourceful agripreneur has gradually extended her venture across the value chain and subsidiary value chains into milk processing and feed production to create a sustainable and successful social enterprise. Lopey Inc operates as a dairy, pasteurizing raw milk to fresh milk, and producing four flavours of drinking yoghurt and a locally popular fermented milk, madila, all under the

Sereledi brand. The products are produced to the highest standards, aiming to meet international benchmarks. The milk is produced by a herd of Jersey, Holstein and Ayrshire cows at Ms Wright's Sereledi Farm. To ensure that the dairy cow herd continues growing, the cows are artificially inseminated using female sexed semen. As a result, the size of her herd had grown six-fold in just five years, from only 10 cows in 2014 to over 60 in 2019. In addition, to maintain high levels of milk yield, Ms Wright purchased an irrigated farm to produce high quality feed continuously. Ms Wright also supplements the feed of her cows – especially during the dry seasons – with silage from her maize fields and store-bought supplies. She benefits from government-subsidized veterinary services. To foster other young Botswana women to get involved in agribusinesses, Ms Wright launched the Sereledi Young Women in Farming Competition in 2016, personally donating the winning prize of BWP 10,000.



Anna Phosa, Dreamland Piggery and Abattoir, South Africa

Anna Phosa

Anna Phosa is the founder of Dreamland piggery – a multi-million-rand family operated farm in South Africa. With an initial personal investment of US\$ 100 to buy 4 pigs in 2004, Ms Phosa has successfully grown this operation to include feed

production and a purchase contract from South Africa's second largest supermarket chains, Pick n' Pay. A small piece of land provided to her by the Department of Agriculture provided a strong boost to transition from a backyard producer to a commercial producer of pigs. Her first contract with the retailer required only the supply of 10 pigs per week. This doubled and then quintupled in just two years by 2010, valued at R25 million deal (approximately US\$ 1.9 million). It was this contract that enabled her to unlock funding from ABSA Bank and USAID in 2011 to buy a 350-hectare farm property where she produces maize to feed the pigs. By 2016, Ms Phosa was contracted to supply 300-350 pigs a week, from her own farm and from other local farmers. She also secured a separate contract in 2018 to supply 50 pigs per week to MassMart, the second-largest distributor of consumer goods on the continent. Dreamland piggery employs 40 permanent staff and 10 seasonal workers, most of whom are youth from nearby farms and informal settlements.



Azieb Tsegay, Dairy, Eritrea

Azieb Tsegay

Mrs Azieb Tsegay is the founder and owner of one of the biggest private dairy farms in Eritrea. Although her venture into livestock keeping began

with poultry farming in 2001, a bird flu epidemic in 2007 forced her to divert into dairy farming. The Ministry of Agriculture guided Mrs Tsegay towards establishing her enterprise in Halhale, north west of Asmara. Growing her herd from an initial investment of only two cows, Mrs Tsegay now owns over 100 cows, producing 700 liters of milk per day and collecting 3000-4000 litres from surrounding farms. The farm employs 30 labourers. She has overcome several challenges including environmental degradation, droughts, and a lack of skilled workforce following lengthy political upheaval. Capitalizing on Eritrea's Italian influence/heritage, her dairy company produces yogurt, butters (traditional herbed flavours, and conventional varieties) and nineteen different types soft and hard cheeses, including mozzarella, ricotta, fontina and grana. Marketing of products is led by her son who specialised in dairy farming in The Netherlands. Their yogurts and cheeses are available at three outlets in Asmara, as well as the hospitality industry across the country. Mrs Tsegay's company is also the lead supplier of dairy products to the mining industry – one of the largest employers in Eritrea. To ensure continuous production of milk and dairy products, Mrs Tsegay has invested in a warehouse to store feed, processing equipment, phytosanitary measures and storage facilities. As a result, she can maintain a regular supply to her markets and while absorbing between 1500 and 4000 litres of milk per day from milk cooperatives nearby.



Hartenbos bewonder volstruise

Op 23 April 2024 het VLV Hartenbos hulle maandelikse lede byeenkoms gehad. By die geleentheid het Mnr en Mev Hannes en Christine Uys, volstruisboere van die plaas Waterkloof in die Heidelberg-distrik, ons toespraak oor volstruise. Hulle is die sewende generasie boere op die plaas Waterkloof waar hulle aanvanklik met Merino skape geboer het. Sy kennis van Merina skape het hom baie gehelp om met volstruise te boer.

Daar is drie soorte volstruise in die wêrld, die swart, blou en gemengde groepe. Die swart soort word gebruik vir die produkte wat kommersieel gebruik word. Die groot "boom"- tyd van volstruise was net mooi 100 jare gelede toe die vere so hoog in die mode was.

Daar is aansienlike verskille tussen wilde volstruise, soos in 'n reservaat, en die wat as broeivoëls gebruik word. Wilde voëls weeg gemiddeld 100kg en hardloop teen 40km per uur. Broeivoëls weeg gemiddeld 150 -160 kg en hardloop teen 150-160 km per uur.

Dit neem nagenoeg een jaar vir 'n kuiken om tot 'n grootte te groei waar dit geslag kan word. In 'n boerdery word die eiers steeds in die natuur gelê waar die boer dit moet kollekteer. Eiers word in 'n broekaste gepak, 800 tot 1000 op 'n slag, waar dit gereeld omgedraai moet word. Teen die einde van die broeiperiode word die eiers in 'n broeimasjien geplaas, waar die kuikens uit die doppe kom. Hulle kan nie self volledig uitkom nie. In die natuur druk die mannetjie volstruis die eier met sy borsbeen verder stukkend sodat die kuiken kan uitkom. In die broeimasjien is dit 'n handmatige proses, wat geweldig arbeidsintensief is. Daarna lê die kuiken onder in die broeimasjien om droog te word.

Hierna gaan die kuikens vir 3-4 maande na 'n grootmaker, wat hulle teen 'n koste, groot maak totdat hulle weer na die boer teruggaan om geslag te word. Sommiges word uitgehou om voortaan as lêvoëls te dien. Hulle word baie fyn gekeur om as lêvoel te kwalifiseer.

Volstruise wat geslag word, het vier hoofprodukte wat ekonomies benut word, nl die vere, vel, eiers en vleis. Elkeen van die produkte het sy eie gebruik en ekonomiese en /of voedselaanwending.

"Vere het weer goud geword". Vere is 'n baie gesogte mode artikels in Europa en Suid-Amerikaanse lande, terwyl verestoffers gewilde uitvoerprodukte na China, VSA, Suid-Amerika en Europa is.

Velle is, persentasie gewys, die duurste van die volstruis produkte en vleis die goedkoopste. Velle word gegradeer in eerste, tweede tot sesde graad. Graad een is die meeste werd, en elke graad ondertoe word minder werd. Die duurste deel van die vel is waar die knoppies die meeste is. Om siektes wat die vel kan beskadig te bekamp, word volstruise gereeld gedip, veral teen bosluise. Bosluisbytplekke wys duidelik op die vel en degradeer die vel.

Die volstruise wat geïdentifiseer word om geslag te word vir vleis, word na hulle grootmaak periode in die veld gejaag om te wei en baie te eet om maksimum vleis te produseer. Volstruisvleis was met die aanvang van produksie so min as R4 per kg, maar het intussen tyd verbeter. Volstruisvleis word hoofsaaklik uitgevoer na België en Nederland. Afvalvleis word uitgevoer as troeteldierkos.

Christine Uys het ons meer vertel van die gebruik van eiers en vleis. Een volstruiseier maak 24 hoendereiers, +- 45 ml volstruiseier maak een gemiddelde hoender eier. Volstruiseier uit die dop, kan geklits word en oortollige eier kan gevries word. Dit bestaan uit een derde geel en twee derde wit en is baie gesond en bevat groot hoeveelhede proteïene.

Christine het ons toegelig oor die verskillende snitte vleis van 'n volstruiskarkas. Kosbare wenke vir die voorbereiding en bediening van volstruisvleis, is met ons gedeel. Filette word in die regte format gekoop, gewoonlik in 'n waaivormige snit. Marinade vir die filet kan gemaak word met olie, braavleis sout, of 'n rooiwynsous. Na voorbereiding moet volstuisfilette dadelik geëet word, dit moenie rus nie.

Ook blokkiesvleis en maalvleis kan voorberei word. 'n Nuttige wenk is dat dit in vog gaargemaak moet word, maar nie water nie. Kry vog van 'n geurige bron soos tamatjie, blatjang of aftreksel. Maalvleis moet voortdurend geroer en hompe vleis plat gedruk word. Sy het n heerlike Bobotie-resep ontwerp, wat baie gewild is onder haar buitelandse toeriste.

Tydens die byeenkoms het die tak ook 'n marktafel gehad. Op die twee marktafels was artikels wat deur lede geskenk is, bv. handgemaakte artikels en artikels om mee handwerk te doen. Dit was 'n reusesukses en sal definitief vooraan ook gehou word.





Strategiese lek-aanvulling gedurende laatdragtigheid & laktasie

Is jou vleisbeeskudde se speen-persentasie dalk laer as gewoonlik of speen jy dalk lichter kalwers? Die rede daarvoor is waarskynlik dat daar nie na behore in die koeie se voedingsbehoeftes gedurende laatdragtigheid en laktasie voorsien word nie. Dit is die periode wat tans vir die meeste kuddes kwessies veroorsaak, en indien klein regstellings gemaak word kan bogenoemde probleem suksesvol opgelos word.

Uit Tabel 1 is dit duidelik dat koeie se proteïnenenergie-behoefte in September vinnig begin toeneem aangesien die groter gedeelte van fetusgroei gedurende die laaste derde van die dragtigheidsperiode plaasvind. Daar teenoor is die proteïeninhoud van beskikbare weiding gedurende hierdie tyd gewoonlik nog laag hoewel hergroei alreeds begin plaasvind.

Dit is dus belangrik om deurlopend 'n proteïen-lek soos **Winterlek 40** te voorsien wat onder andere

degradeerbare proteïen verskaf sodat daar voldoende stikstof in die rumen beskikbaar is om laag-verteerbare vesel in beskikbare weiding te verteer. Daarbenewens word noodsaklike makro-minerale by voorbeeld fosfor, asook spoorminerale en vitamiene aangevul.

Met die begin van die kalf-seisoen in Oktober begin die voedingsbehoeftes van die koei drasties styg en hoewel die voedingswaarde van die veld stadig begin verbeter is dit nie naastenby

voldoende om aan die voedingsbehoeftes vir laktasie te voldoen nie (Tabel 1).

Melkproduksie van die koei piek gewoonlik na twee maande (Tabel 1) wat beteken dat haar voedingsbehoeftes die heel hoogste gedurende November/Desember sal wees. Dit raak derhalwe dan belangrik om na **Produksielek 20** oor te skakel om energie, proteïen en minerale aan te vul. Hierdie praktyk moet volgehou word totdat dit voldoende gereën het.

Vanaf Januarie styg die proteïen-inhoud van weiding vinnig. Daling in NDF (vesel) en lignieninhoud vind ook plaas wat tot gevolg het dat meer energie vir melk-produksie beskikbaar is. Daarbenewens begin melkproduksie geleidelik daal (Tabel 1).

Die netto-resultaat van hierdie veranderinge in dat natuurlike weiding gewoonlik nou in die voedingsbehoeftes van lakterende koeie kan voorsien met die uitsondering van sout en fosfaat. Dis is derhalwe nou raadsaam om van Sernick Produksielek 20 oor te skakel na **Soutfos 6**.

Dit is belangrik om daar op te let dat fosfor noodsaklik vir energie-benutting en tesame met kalsium ook noodsaklik is vir beenvorming. Dit is ook onder Suid-Afrikaanse toestande bewys dat fosfaat-aanvulling vrugbaarheid van koeie dramaties kan verhoog in gebiede waar natuurlike weiding fosfaat-gebrekkig is.

Indien bees 'n fosfaat-tekort het sal hulle begin om bene in die veld te vreet (Pika) wat kan aanleiding gee tot lamsiekte.

Dit word bereken dat lakterende koeie se fosforinname gedurende laktasie so laag as 11g per dag kan wees, terwyl die fosfor-behoefte van lakterende vleisbeeskoeie in die orde van 22g per dag is (Tabel 1). Dit spreek dus vanself dat fosfor gedurende die somer aangevul moet word.

Benewens fosfaat-aanvulling is soutfosfaat-lekke ook noodsaklik om sout (NaCl) aan te vul. Sout is 'n essensiële dieet-komponent wat help om waterbalans in die dier se liggaam te handhaaf. Soutbehoefte word in die somer verhoog deurdat sout in die vorm van sweet verlore gaan.

Samevattend moet dit beklemtoon word dat die melkproduksie van die koei die belangrikste faktor is wat speenmassa bepaal en deur strategiese lekaanvulling bestuur kan word.

Rekonsepsie, en gevvolglike kalfpersentasie, word grootliks deur die kondisie van die koei met dekking bepaal en kan eweneens met lekaanvulling geoptimaliseer word. Minerale aanvulling kan ook 'n beduidende positiewe effek op konsepsie hê.

Die lek-keuse word deur 'n groot verskeidenheid faktore bepaal waarvan die veldtoestand en diere se kondisie die belangrikste is. Kontak gerus u plaaslike Sernick tegniese adviseur vir spesifieke aanbevelings wat spreek tot jou kudde se behoeftes.



Annual harvest is about 2.5 million head. The majority of the harvested animals come from feedlots that produce an average carcass weight of 240 kg (528 lb) with less than 13% fat.

Dairy Farming is popular all over the world. It is a great way for farmers to double their income and access to more nutritious food for their families. While subsistence dairy farming gives not only fresh milk and a source of basic income, value-added products like yogurt and cheese, provide a higher source of revenue. To start with dairy farming, you can select some of the top cattle breeds in the country, with the help of experts.

4. Sheep Farming

Sheep farming is also a lucrative business for the farmers. One can raise sheep for its meat and fibre. But, you need to choose specific breeds depending on the agro-climatic condition of your region.

5. Fish Farming




